El Hegez Island is a small island which is located in the north of Edfu. We will spend our first night here. (BLD)

The Nagui Museum used to be the artist's studio and remains one of the city's most pleasant surprises for art aficionados. After graduating in Lyon, France, Nagui opted to move to Florence, where he became the first Egyptian to study at the Florence Academy of Fine Arts. In addition to a six-year stint in Florence starting in 1919, Nagui studied briefly in the atelier of the great impressionist, Claude Monet. Back to our hotel for overnight stay at Cairo. (B)

Day 6 SATURDAY-MUSEUM OF MAHMOUD KHALIL

Another must-see on the summer art circuit is the Museum of Mr. and Mrs. Mohamed Mahmoud Khalil which houses the late couple's stunning collection of European art & fine Egyptian arts
